SAMPLE COURSE SEQUENCE – SUBJECT TO REVISION**

An individual student's program may differ from this sample according to his/her background and educational goals. Each student must meet with his/her faculty advisor every quarter to review progress in the program and plan coursework for future quarters. A minimum of **79** units is required for preparation as a family nurse practitioner. Students receiving funding from the Graduate Division must enroll in at least 12 units each quarter. Students must meet with their faculty advisor each quarter.
